


CARNIVALS. February March.

WOMEN'S DAY. March 8. Around this date different events are organised that emphasise marking gender inequality and discrimination.

#### HOLY WEEK March / April.

The Christian commemoration of the Passion of Christ. Magnificent symbiosis of baroque and ascetics; the marching bands and observance. Holy Week is unmissable; to the believer wrapped in the intimate ritual, or those who love to delight in this enraptured spectacle of silence, incense and drops of wax.

Religious brotherhoods come together in Alcalá de los Gazules, a living procession on Palm Sunday, children dressed in Hebrew clothing, clapping and olive trees, recreating the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. In Barbate, daily processions, chargers,penitents, nazarenes ... From balconies and windows in Benalup- Casas Viejas the neighbors deposit wreaths of flowers as Jesus Christ's representation passes.

In Conil de la Frontera, solemnity and sacred music at a magnificent festivity. Stunning images pass through Medina Sidonia's labyrinth of narrow and steep streets. In Paterna de Rivera, land of singers, the number of saetas that are sung and their traditional "Bull of Hallelujah". Passion, emotion and dedication can be seen t in San José del Valle, accomplanied by the sound of footsteps on the cobblestones...
